


### NUMBER OF STUDENTS




# RESEARCH PERFORMANCE


- 433 LSMU scientific papers ranked in the top 10% of the most cited scientific articles worldwide, published over the past decade (2023).\*
- 72 ongoing international research projects are currently conducted at LSMU, including 29 funded by European Commission competitions, such as modernAKIS, EBRAINS, ONCOSCREEN, AURORA, and VOLABIOS.






### LARGE ANIMAL CLINIC
